Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is the purpose and intent of the "Operations and Reference Manual for Weed Officers"?

- A. For new Weed Officers, it gives an easy way to access information on existing programs, regulations and resources available for noxious weed control.
- B. For experienced Weed Officers it is a continuing education resource to review existing techniques. It also provides a showcase for new methods and new ideas on weed control.

2. Are the reference materials listed on this website available for redistribution or re-printing?

- A. Access to links on this site is not restricted. Most of the links are government sources that encourage the use and distribution of information.
- B. However, it's recommended that anyone wishing to copy and distribute source material check on the requirements of each authoring agency for permission and distribution rights before doing so.

3. Can the Manual be edited or updated?

Yes, links and material can easily be edited or content expanded. It's intended that the Manual will evolve to stay relevant as new issues arise. Please send suggestions for revisions or additions to the NDWCA Education Committee for review and approval.

4. What format is required for posted or linked information?
