

North Dakota Noxious Weeds List

Regulations – Chapter 7-06-02 - Noxious Weeds Listed

Weeds declared noxious shall be confined to weeds that are difficult to control, easily spread, and injurious to public health, crops, livestock, land or other property. The following weeds have been declared noxious for the purpose of North Dakota Century Code chapter 63-0 1. 1:

1. Absinth Wormwood (*Artemisia absinthium* L.)
2. Canada thistle (*Cirsium arvense* (L.) Scop.)
3. Dalmation toadflax (*Linaria genistifolia* ssp. *dalmatica*)
4. Diffuse knapweed (*Centaurea diffusa* Lam.)
5. Field Bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis* L.)
6. Leafy Spurge (*Euphorbia esula* L.)
7. Musk thistle (*Carduus nutans* L.)
8. Purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria* L., *Lythrum virgatum* L. and all cultivars)
9. Russian knapweed (*Acroptilon repens* (L.) DC.)
10. Saltcedar (*Tamarix ramosissima* Ledeb., including *T. chinensis* and *T. parviflora* DC.)
11. Spotted knapweed (*Centaurea maculosa* Lam.)
12. Yellow starthistle (*Centaurea solstitialis* L.)
